## Care Tips



Cabomba is easy to grow and care for, but it's a fast-growing plant, so you'll want to keep it under control by trimming it regularly, making sure to discard the cuttings outside and away from the pond. Prune and trim the leaves and flowers of your plant as soon as they turn brown. Cabomba can be left in the pond over winter, as it will grow dormant and grow back in Spring. Be sure to trim off any dead foliage and trim the plant down before winter sets in.
