Care Tips



Fertilize once a month, preferably June through August. To overwinter in hardiness zones 8 or higher, leave your calla lilies in dry soil so they can go dormant (move them if they are in your pond). Moist soil may lead to rotting. In colder zones, before the first frost, lift the plants from the soil, trim the dried foliage off, and air-dry the bulbs. Store the bulbs in a cool, dark area throughout the winter. You should replant in the spring as soon as the frost is over.
