Care Tips



Water Hyacinths grow extremely fast. Thin your plant population by removing a batch and discarding them away from your pond. For extremely thick roots, use scissors to cut off a batch. If the leaves turn yellow or flowers stop blooming, pull the plants and place them in a tub with a water/fertilizer mix for a few days. When ready, pull them from the tub, rinse them off, and place back in pond. Zones 8 and lower, discard plants at the end of the first frost.
